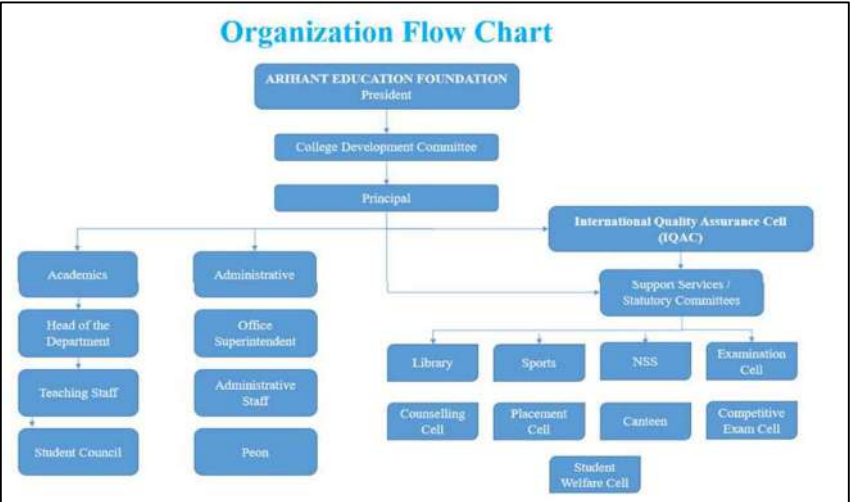

This includes claims which are sometimes referred to as Student Complaints.</p> <p>Such grievances may include but are not confined to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The unfair assessment, of course, work not otherwise governed by University assessment and examination regulations. 2. An unfair refusal or failure of the staff member to make him/ her available to assist a student with difficulties regarding his/her course work. 3. Unreasonable delays in the assessment of course work. 4. Inadequate course materials. 5. Inadequate teaching. 6. Deficient performance of associated administrative services.

Upholding the principles of human rights and acknowledging their indispensable role in shaping individual growth, our Grievance Redressal Committee (GRC) stands dedicated to attentively addressing and resolving grievances brought forth by any student, ensuring fairness and accountability in our pursuit of excellence</p> <p>Step 1: Submission of Grievance</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visit the institute's official website and navigate to the "Feedback" section. • Click on the "Online Grievance Form" button to access the online grievance submission form. • Fill out the required fields, including personal information (name, email, contact number), nature of grievance, department involved, and any supporting documents. • Review the grievance details and submit the form. <p>Step 2: Acknowledgement and Processing</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Upon receiving the grievance, an acknowledgement email will be sent to the complainant, confirming receipt of the grievance. • The Grievance Redressal Officer (GRO) will review the submitted grievance within 24 hours and assign it a unique reference number for tracking purposes. • The GRO will categorize the grievance based on its nature and severity and initiate the investigation process. <p>Step 3: Investigation and Resolution</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The GRO will investigate the grievance by gathering relevant information, interviewing involved parties, and assessing available evidence. • Depending on the complexity of the grievance, the GRO may form a grievance redressal committee comprising faculty members, administrators, and student representatives to facilitate resolution. • The grievance redressal committee will deliberate on the matter and propose appropriate solutions or actions to address the grievance. • The GRO will communicate the proposed resolution to the complainant via email within the stipulated timeframe. <p>Step 4: Appeal Process (if applicable)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If the complainant is not satisfied with the proposed resolution, they may submit an appeal within a specified timeframe (e.g., 7 days) from the date of receiving the resolution. • The appeal will be reviewed by a higher authority designated by the institute's management, such as the Director. • The appellate authority will conduct a thorough review of the grievance and may seek additional information or clarification from the parties involved and will issue a final decision on the grievance <p>Step 5: Closure and Feedback</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Once the grievance is resolved or a final decision is made, the case will be marked as closed in the online grievance portal. • The complainant will have the opportunity to provide feedback on their experience with the grievance redressal process through a satisfaction survey or feedback form.
